



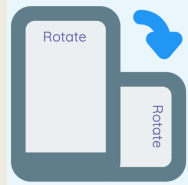
## Creating Media - Photo Editing



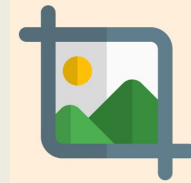

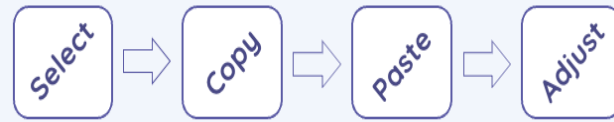

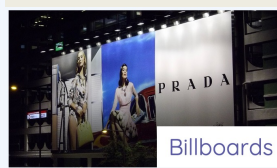
This picture has been edited. A filter has been added and it has changed the photograph. Have you ever edited a picture?

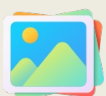

## KEY VOCABULARY

<b>Image</b>	a representation of the external form of a person or thing
<b>Edit</b>	remove unnecessary things from a text, film, or radio or television programme
<b>Digital</b>	involving or relating to the use of computer technology.
<b>Crop</b>	remove part of (a photograph or other image) in order to produce a better picture or to fit a given space.
<b>Rotate</b>	move or cause to move in a circle round an axis or centre.
<b>Save</b>	keep (data) by moving a copy to a storage location.
<b>Undo</b>	cancel (the last command executed by a computer).
<b>Effects</b>	the lighting, sound, or scenery used in a play, film, or broadcast.
<b>Retouch</b>	improve or repair (a painting, photograph, or other image) by making slight additions or alterations
<b>Alter</b>	make structural changes to
<b>Adjustments</b>	a small <u>alteration</u> or movement made to achieve a desired fit, appearance, or result
<b>Foreground</b>	the part of a view that is nearest to the observer, especially in a picture or photograph
