



## Key Vocabulary

<b>abstract art</b>	Art which uses colours, lines and shapes but does not represent objects or living things.
<b>primary colours</b>	Red, yellow and blue are <b>primary colours</b> . They can't be made by mixing other colours.
<b>secondary colours</b>	Orange, green and purple are <b>secondary colours</b> . They are made by mixing two <b>primary colours</b> together.
<b>tertiary colours</b>	These are made by mixing <b>primary colours</b> and <b>secondary colours</b> together.
<b>neutral colours</b>	Brown, black, grey and white are <b>neutral colours</b> .
<b>tints</b>	These are created by adding white to a colour. This makes a colour lighter.
<b>shades</b>	These are created by adding black to a colour. This makes a colour darker.
<b>warm colours</b>	Red, orange and yellow are <b>warm colours</b> . They make us think of warm and cosy things.
<b>cool colours</b>	Green, blue and purple are <b>cool colours</b> . They make us think of fresh, calm or chilly things.
