In Maths, Nursery have been exploring shape. The children have selected shapes which will fit when rotated or flipped in inset boards, shape sorters and jigsaws.



Reception have been working on number recognition. The children have been matching quantities to the numeral and have been forming the numerals in a variety of ways. They love learning maths outdoors!



Year 1 have been experimenting with materials to find out which objects float and sink. They sorted them and found out that some do both! Cotton wool was absorbant and floated until it got too heavy!



Year 5 have produced some fantastic homework, including beautifully designed Greek travel brochures, detailed shields and imaginative poems. In Maths, the class have been exploring a range of strategies for mental addition and subtraction, while in Science they've been learning about Copernicus and his ground-breaking theories about the solar system. Everyone has also been working hard in music, practising the songs ready for our upcoming Harvest celebration.



Year 6 have had another wonderful week! With two trips and lots of wonderful learning in the classroom it certainly was action-packed! They had a great time both travelling back in time to the 1940s at Brampton Museum to find out the impact WW2 had on our local area followed by Crucial Crew last Friday to learn all about keeping themselves safe and healthy.
