Nursery have taken part in World Nursery Rhyme Week. The children learned five new rhymes, with 'Two Little Dickie Birds' becoming an instant favourite! Making their own birds was a real hit too, a perfect way to bring the rhyme to life.



The children in Reception absolutely loved their Superhero day with Bee Active! They learnt all the skills needed to defeat the mischievous Evil Bee; travelling with speed, spinning their shields, rolling away from danger and jumping to safety. It was a brilliant, energetic day!

Year 1 have been history detectives. They visited Nantwich Museum to explore the similarities and differences between The Great Fire of London and The Great Fire of Nantwich. They dressed in replica Tudor clothes, wrote with feather quills, investigated artefacts and walked around Nantwich to learn more about the fabulous history that our town holds.



Year 2 have continued to explore simple systems in DT. They explored the pivots and levels in their own bodies and enjoyed being engineers to create moving skeletons.



Year 5 have been wonderfully creative. They've been busy designing Christmas cards for the Mayor's annual competition, all based on the theme 'Christmas in Nantwich'. The children have come up with some fantastic ideas, from festive scenes in the town square to drawings of a snowy St Mary's Church.

In PE, they've been developing their hockey skills. The class have been working hard on controlling the ball using a range of techniques, showing great teamwork, focus and improvement each lesson.
