<p>Task 1: Science</p> <p>Create a list of electrical items you can find at home. You could even do this and a few others in Top Trumps style for extra dojos.</p>	<p>Task 8: ART</p> <p>Write a Roman menu – include starters, mains, sides, desserts and drinks – make it look a bit Roman if you can 😊</p>
