Year 3 have been Geographers, using world maps and atlases to locate the world's longest rivers. They then added them onto a blank world map and extended their knowledge by identifying the different parts of a river.

Year 4 walked around school inside and out with their iPads. They activated special sensors to log data on how bright or dull various areas were, and recorded line graph snapshots that they'll discuss in their next Science lesson.



In DT, Year 5 children thoroughly enjoyed cooking and making their own delicious pizza muffins. They demonstrated great teamwork, independence and pride in their finished products (and they smelled amazing!).

In Science, they've been learning about the different parts of a flower and how plants reproduce. The children are now able to explain the roles of the anther, stigma, ovary and ovule and describe the process of pollination and fertilisation using accurate scientific vocabulary.

Year 6 have been smashing their area and measurement unit challenging themselves to find the areas of different triangles. It was tricky but they were so resilient and able to crack the formula! Well done!
